**BILL TOPIC: RIGHT TO HUNT WILDLIFE** 

NOTE: This bill was not enacted into law; therefore, the impacts identified in this analysis

do not take effect.

#### **Summary of Legislation**

The bill modifies the legislative declaration in Colorado wildlife law to clarify that Coloradans will always have the right to hunt, fish, and harvest wildlife and establishes that these are the primary methods of controlling and managing wildlife.

#### **Assessment**

Because a legislative declaration does not have the force of law, this bill is assessed as having no fiscal impact. The bill does not affect the revenue or expenditures of any state agency.

#### **Effective Date**

The bill was postponed indefinitely by the House State, Veterans, and Military Affairs Committee on May 2, 2016.
