- 8. Student Health and Wellness Building Feasibility Study
  - "Last fall, Student Government initiated a mental health taskforce to assess the mental health climate at ISU and propose feedback and solutions for related resources. I've attached the final report for your reference. One of the recommendations was to build a new student health building on campus to provide a central location for students seeking physical and mental health assistance. Because Thielen Student Health Center (TSHC), Student Counseling Services (SCS), and Student Wellness (SW) are all in different locations, the taskforce felt like a combined building would go a long way to decreasing stigma and improving efficiency of student health and wellness services. Thanks to this recommendation and your support, I'm pleased to share that ISU's Capital Projects Advisory Committee (CPAC) approved a health and wellness building feasibility study that will investigate the options for a shared facility."
  - o The architect firm plans to initiate a student survey as part of the project, and would also like to hold a student feedback session on August 29th from 5:30 − 7 pm (location TBD- pizza will be provided).
