1 2019-2020 2 3rd Session 3 2019-3-0XX SR 4 5 In the Iowa State University Student Government Senate 6 January 15, 2020 7 Senator Stanley (for himself and Senator Heasley) introduced the following resolution. 8 **A RESOLUTION** 9 10 11 TITLE: Endorsing the University Library's Principles for Advancing Openness through Journal 12 **Negotiations** 13 14 WHEREAS: In the last two years, university libraries nationwide have begun to take stronger stances 15 during negotiations with journal publishers with the aim of procuring fair and reasonable 16 subscription and publication costs, and 17 18 WHEREAS: This also helps further the noble goal of free and open access to research papers and 19 findings for all who wish to peruse them, and 20 21 WHEREAS: As a land-grant institution, Iowa State University was founded with an imperative to 22 23 disseminate the knowledge created here for the benefit of Iowans and the world at large, 24 25 WHEREAS: Journal publishers use predatory tactics such as forcing researchers to sign over the bulk 26 of the intellectual rights to their own works as a condition for publishing and compelling 27 28 universities to sign non-disclosure agreements regarding the details of their subscriptions to extort tremendous profit margins from universities which in some cases exceed 30 29 30 31 32 percent, and WHEREAS: Iowa State University has been and is currently a victim of these tactics, as the University Library pays a substantially disproportionate rate for the services of some journal 33 publishers when compared to many peer institutions, and 34 35 Cancellation of journal subscriptions has been used as a successful strategy by WHEREAS: 36 universities which refuse to submit to these underhanded tricks any longer, most notably 37 by the University of California during their negotiations with the journal publisher 38 Elsevier in 2019, and 39 40 WHEREAS: The example of the University of California, as well as landmark agreements regarding 41 cost reduction and open access in France and Germany, provide an opportunity to explore 42 43 previously infeasible possibilities in our own negotiations with journal publishers, and 44 WHEREAS: The University Library has released a document titled, "Principles for Advancing 45 Openness through Journal Negotiations," which details the stance that the Library will 46 take during negotiations moving forward in order to advance the joint goals of open 47 access and proportional costs, and 48 49 WHEREAS: The Library Advisory Committee and the Faculty Senate have both endorsed this 50 document, be it therefore 51 52 53 That the Iowa State University Student Government endorse this document and affirm RESOLVED: their support for any action the University Library may take during these negotiations 54 which adheres to these principles, and be it further
