Transfer students must also include unofficial transcripts from their other schools.

Complementary Studies

Bachelor of Arts students must complete at least 12 units of Complementary Studies outside of the primary prefix for the major. The School of Music accepts any upper- or lower-division courses outside of the major, as all subjects feed and serve us as artists.
