



CUI Notice 2022-01: Executive Agent Guidance Regarding White House National Security Council (NSC) Memorandum, “Initiating a Process to Review Information Management and Classification Policies,” June 2, 2022.

September 7, 2022

Purpose

1. This Notice provides Controlled Unclassified Information (CUI) Executive Agent guidance with respect to NSC Memorandum, *Initiating a Process to Review Information Management and Classification Policies*, dated June 2, 2022.

Authorities

2. Executive Order 13556, “Controlled Unclassified Information,” (the Order) November 10, 2010.
3. 32 CFR Part 2002, “Controlled Unclassified Information,” (the Directive) September 14, 2016.

Background

4. The NSC has initiated an interagency policy committee (IPC) process to review Executive Orders 13526, “Classified National Security Information” and 13556 “Controlled Unclassified Information”. ISOO fully supports and is participating in this IPC process to assist with standardizing and modernizing information security management policies that govern classified national security information and CUI across the executive branch.

5. Efforts to create a standardized information protection and sharing system for all sensitive unclassified information that the government handles and protects has been a major endeavor requiring significant coordination. Such changes also require strong institutional and program support. There is much work still to be done, but as a direct result of the years of implementation efforts that have already taken place across the government, we are seeing continual forward movement towards standardization.

Guidance

6. Throughout the NSC IPC review process, agencies should continue to safeguard and handle CUI in accordance with the applicable federal laws, regulations, and Government-wide policy authorities governing this sensitive information.
