## NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1. RULES

1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*.

# 2. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to all alumni of the Reyburn Sailing School.
- 2.2 Competitors shall register for the regatta on a first-come, first-serve basis. Entry will be limited to 48 sailors. Registration must be completed at the regatta website <a href="https://www.erieyachtclub.org/alumni-regatta-registration">https://www.erieyachtclub.org/alumni-regatta-registration</a> before 11 am on Saturday, May 25, 2024.

# 3. BOATS AND CLASSES

- 3.1 Races will be sailed the club's 420's, no spinnakers.
- 3.2 There will be 1 or 2 divisions, depending on the number of participants. Boats and divisions will be assigned at the skippers meeting based on order of registration. Crew will rotate boats based on a schedule to be distributed at the skippers meeting.

#### 4. FEES

- 4.1 The entry fee is \$25 per person.
- 4.2 There will be a \$10 fee for non-sailors who wish to participate in the shore activities.

## 5. SCHEDULE

- 5.1 Check-in will be Saturday, May 25, 2024 from 10:00 11:00 am. at the Rickloff Community Boathouse.
- 5.2 Skipper's meeting will be at 11:00 am.
- 5.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is noon. We will sail as many races as possible. No races will be started after 4:00 pm.

#### 6. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

6.1 The sailing instructions will be available on the regatta website by Friday, May 24, 2024 and at the check-in table.

## 7. THE COURSES

7.1 The courses to be sailed will be short windward-leeward, once or twice around depending on wind.

#### 8. PENALTY SYSTEM

- 8.1 Protests will be heard by your fellow sailors who have probably been drinking in a quick, informal hearing.
- 8.2 Decisions of the protest committee will be final as provided in rule 70.5.

#### 9. PRIZES

- 9.1 The winner of each class will receive a flag and their names on a perpetual trophy (if there are two classes there will be two winners).
- 9.2 Additional awards will be made for teams that meet certain demographic and geographic criteria (youngest, oldest, travelled the furthest, etc.) and for the most Corinthian crew.
