HOURS OF OPERATION: Monday-Friday: 0800-1600, Closed federal and training holidays

LOCATION: USCENTCOM In-Processing Center, 7115 S. Boundary Blvd, Bldg. 571, Rm 114 (to the left inside the Visitor's Center)

REQUIRED ITEMS:

- "QUARANTINED" members will "NOT" IN/Out-Process in Person, See Note 1 & 2
- All newcomers (military, civilian, contractor) "MUST" have a sponsor/supervisor from their Directorate with them. If not, they will be redirected to contact their sponsor/supervisor. If no one is available from their assigned Directorate, the newcomer will "NOT" In-Process. See Note 1 & 2
- Out-Processing members "MUST" sign-in on the kiosk in person to receive a checklist, no sponsor needed.
- All Active Duty members "MUST" provide their ETP. Contact your Directorate for more information.
- All military members "MUST" be in uniform and have at least two copies of their orders.
- Army personnel will also need to provide their leave form(s).
- Contractors "MUST" have a CAC card from their assigned Contracting Company.
- All personnel visiting the In-Processing Center "MUST" have a current CAC.

NOTES:

- 1. If you are feeling any COVID symptoms, self-quarantine. Do "NOT" In-Process in person. Contact your Directorate sponsor/supervisor immediately. Per Command Guidance for HQ USCENTCOM Staff.
- 2. If you must quarantine, do "NOT" show up to USCENTCOM in person. Contact your Directorate sponsor/supervisor for instructions or reference the Command Guidance for HQ USCENTCOM Staff.
- 3. No one is available outside of normal business hours for In-Processing or signing leave form(s).
- 4. Electronic devices (cell phones, tablets, smart watches, etc.) are "NOT" allowed in any building on the USCENTCOM compound.
- 5. All personnel will In-Process with the In-Processing Center (IPC) prior to visiting the SSO Office for their Security Badge.

We are here to serve your child(ren)'s educational needs.

Prior to departing for MacDill, we recommend you do the following: (Reference: MacDill School Liaison Transition Checklist and Interstate Compact Agreement)

- 1. Provide current school your official withdrawal date request an unofficial copy of records to hand carry.
- 2. Obtain an unofficial copy of all your records (including testing, advanced placement, IEPs, BIP, 504 plans, etc.).
- 3. Transcript/record documentation requirements (ensure they are clearly annotated).
 - State/standardized or special program testing
 - · Advanced placement courses/dual credit
 - IEPs
 - 504 plan
 - Gifted & talented testing/classes
 - Working outside of grade level (e.g., taking 10th grade math but in the 8th grade)
- 4. On the day of withdrawal, obtain an unofficial transcript/record (listed above) with grades closed out as of that day (if departing during summer break, ensure copy states passed/promoted and obtain prior to office closure).
- 5. Other documents to obtain or have
 - · Report card/course history/schedule
 - Counselor recommendations for placement (optional)
 - JROTC records (if applicable)
 - Listing of academic recognitions/competition participation
 - Academic grading system overview, weighted grade system (e.g., Scale 5.0, 4.0, etc.)
- 6. If you are currently overseas and enrolled in a DoDEA Non-DoD Schools Program (NDSP) School, please obtain a duplicate transcript from DoDEA that will transfer correctly into the American public system (DoDEA will pay for if you have not exhausted your funds).
- 7. The Youth/Teen Center located On-Base offers a Youth Sponsorship Program for 9-18 year-olds. If you have a student who is interested in connecting with other children On-Base

Harbor Bay (HB - is our Privatized Housing partner.

Housing on the installation is limited and extensive wait times can be expected for some of our rank bands and entitlements. Accurate documentation and providing all application paperwork is imperative to proper eligibility screening by MHO; and then will ensure that our privatized housing partner HB can properly place potential residents

on the applicable wait list. The most important factor is the effective date you leave your last duty location; this date is what all on base applications are racked and stacked against. Several factors can affect wait list placement and movement, such as Key and Essential positions, remote credit, hardship, EFMP and medical accommodations. The MHO can provide invaluable relocation assistance on all these requirements and assist in proper application submission.

Rental Partnership Program (RPP) - Is managed by our office, and currently contains 40 apartment complexes. These apartment complexes give discounts ranging from 5% to 10% off the market rate, requires no application fee and no security deposit; except pet deposits. The program requires a 7-12 month lease and automatic allotment from your paycheck. To be on the program and receive the paperwork, you must be active duty assigned to MacDill (not on TDY) and attend a 10-15 minute briefing (no appointment necessary). You must also submit a copy of your PCS orders assigning you to MacDill AFB.

At the end of the fellowship (or at any point during the fellowship), the spouse will hopefully have a chance to interview for a full-time role.




