Bachelor Complex, Deschutes NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 3). IMT is also managing the Flat Top and Firestone fires. Twenty miles southwest of Bend, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Flat Top, Deschutes NF, USFS. Ten miles north of Fort Rock, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Moderate fire behavior with isolated torching, short-range spotting and smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Firestone, Deschutes NF, USFS. Twenty-one miles north of Fort Rock, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Energy and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect. Reduction in acreage due to more accurate mapping.

Willamette Complex (4 fires), Willamette NF, USFS. CIMT (NR Team 6) and CIMT (EA Team 1). IMTs are also managing the Red and Ore fires. Eight miles southeast of Oakridge, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering, creeping and flanking. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Red, Deschutes NF, USFS. Eighteen miles west of Crescent, OR. Timber and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ore, Willamette NF, USFS. Seven miles northeast of Blue River, OR. Closed timber litter and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Devils Knob, Umpqua NF, USFS. Transfer of command from CIMT (NW Team 13) back to the local unit will occur 9/21. Five miles southeast of Tiller, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Rail Ridge, Prineville, District, BLM. Transfer of command from CIMT (CA Team 10) to CIMT (AK Team 3) will occur tomorrow. Fifty-one miles northwest of Burns, OR. Grass, brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Numerous structures, communication infrastructure and sage-grouse habitat threatened. Evacuations, area, road and trail closures in effect.

Buck Creek, Fremont-Winema NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 10). Thirty miles southwest of Silver Lake, OR. Timber and medium slash. Moderate fire behavior with creeping, single tree torching and smoldering. Area and road closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Wiley Flat, Ochoco NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 1). Thirty-one miles southeast of Prineville, OR. Timber, brush and grass. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Homestead Complex (4 fires), Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (NW Team 7). Thirty miles northeast of Glide, OR. Timber, closed timber litter and brush. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Fossil Complex (3 fires), Fossil Unit, ODF. Transfer of command from IMT 1 (ODF Team 2) to IMT 1 (ODF Team 3) will occur today. Two miles northwest of Spray, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering and creeping. Structures and communication infrastructure threatened.

Diamond Complex (2 fires), Umpqua NF, USFS. CIMT (CA Team 14). IMT is also managing the Middle Fork fire. Eighteen miles southwest of Chemult, OR. Timber. Minimal fire behavior with smoldering. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Middle Fork, Crater Lake NP, NPS. Fourteen miles northeast of Union Creek, OR. Timber. No new information.

Whisky Creek, Mt. Hood NF, USFS. Six miles southeast of Cascade Locks, OR. Timber, brush and closed timber litter. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and smoldering. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Swauk Creek, Southeast Region, Washington DNR. Two miles south of Liberty, WA. Brush and timber. Minimal fire behavior with creeping and backing. Structures threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Ruby, North Cascades NP, NPS. Thirty-two miles northwest of Stehekin, WA. Timber and brush. Minimal fire behavior with backing, creeping and smoldering. Area and trail closures in effect. Precipitation occurred over the fire area yesterday.

Williams Mine, Gifford Pinchot NF, USFS. Four miles northwest of Trout Lake, WA. Brush, timber and light slash. Minimal fire behavior with backing and creeping. Energy infrastructure threatened. Area, road and trail closures in effect.

Predictive Services Discussion:

An upper-level low will move slowly into southern California, with scattered showers and isolated thunderstorms along the central Coast Ranges into the Sierra and central Nevada. Strong onshore flow will continue in southern California, with dry and breezy conditions in the Southwest. Above normal temperatures will continue in the Front Range onto the High Plains with minimum relative humidity of 8-25% along with locally breezy south winds. Relative humidity will be sharply lower across the Texas/Oklahoma panhandles tomorrow than previous days. Dry conditions with near normal temperatures and light winds will spread from the Northwest into the northern Great Basin and northern Rockies. Scattered showers will continue on the east slopes of the central Appalachians to the Carolinas. It will remain dry for the Great Lakes, northern New England, and Lower Ohio Valley, but moderation of relative humidity is likely to continue as minima remain above 30%, while scattered showers and thunderstorms are expected in the Mid/Upper Mississippi Valley.
