



## The SUNY Oswego Student Health Fee

SUNY Oswego is committed to supporting the well-being of all students. The Health Fee, paid by all students regardless of course modality, location, and matriculation status, goes to support the staff and strategies needed to create and maintain a culture of care on our campus. The Fee funds both in-person and remote programs, clinical care, and other strategies offered by multiple departments in the Division of Student Affairs including the Office of the Dean of Students (ODS), Student Health Services (SHS), and Counseling Services (CSC).

*Telemedicine and telecounseling are only available to SUNY Oswego students currently studying in New York State. International and online students studying outside of New York State are not eligible.*
