Strategic Plan

- Resilient Great Lakes Basin
 - ✓ Coastal Resilience; Science Planning and Coordination
- Clean and Safe Water
- Sustainable and Equitable Water Use
- Safe and Reliable Waterways
 - ✓ Navigation/Maritime Transportation; Recreation/Tourism; Dredging
- Healthy Aquatic Ecosystems



SEPTEMBER 6, 2023

FY 2023 Congressional Appropriation

First direct appropriation to the GLC

✓ Will help build staff capacity to implement strategic plan priorities.

Work Plan calls for:

- Expanded work in maritime transportation; hiring a maritime project manager
- Expanded work in resiliency; implementing the Climate Resilience
 Action Plan; hiring a resilience project manager
- Expanding partnerships; hiring a tribal/indigenous peoples liaison



SEPTEMBER 6, 2023

Climate Resilience Action Plan

- Adopted by the GLC in 2022
- Includes short-term, mid-term and long-term actions and desired outcomes for four goals

Goals include:

- Healthy and sustainable communities
- Safe and resilient buildings and infrastructure
- ✓ Healthy and adaptive ecosystems
- Ecosystem and public services that support a healthy economy



SEPTEMBER 6, 2023

Small Harbors & Coastal Communities Committee

- Formed by the GLC in 2021 to:
 - ✓ Identify needs and priorities for small harbors and coastal communities and issue a report to the GLC
 - ✓ Update GLC policy in these areas
- Report to be presented at the 2023 Annual Meeting in Ohio
- Report includes high level findings/actions for:
 - Dredging and sediment management
 - ✓ Harbor infrastructure maintenance, repair and safety
 - ✓ Sustainable coastal communities



SEPTEMBER 6, 2023

Environmental Windows for Dredging

- Completed multi-year project on science-based strategies for dredging windows in Lake Michigan in 2021
- Outcomes included:
 - ✓ Full-day virtual symposium and a half-day state workshop in April 2021
 - Proceedings of the symposium and workshop
 - ✓ Bibliography of research
 - Documentation of state priorities and needs (through the workshop)
 - Findings and next steps

Phase two effort desired:

- Expand participation to involve all Great Lakes states and dredgers
- ✓ Identify funding partners
