Seasonal Safety Campaign

- **Covers hazards typically seen in a 3 month period**
- **Flexibility to target hazards:**
 - General messaging during the season
 - When a hazard is forecast to occur
 - When a hazard is occurring
- **Materials Created – consistent message**
 - Social Media Messages, News Articles, Safety Website, videos and/or graphics

FEMA



National

- Seasonal Campaigns
- Specific launch dates:
March 1, June 1,
September 1, December 1.
- Covers multiple hazards per campaign.
- Can focus on the hazards as they are happening across the U.S.

Local

- Awareness/Preparedness Weeks
- Dates are determined by the local forecast office and partners.
- Focus on a single hazard during week.
- Weeks are held at a relevant time of year so the messaging is not lost!
